Cheltenham College is one of the UK's leading co-educational independent schools for both day and boarding pupils aged 3–18 (boarding from age 7). Offering outstanding all-round education within a warm and vibrant community, the school is situated in 72 acres of beautiful grounds in the heart of the Cotswolds. The Prep School (3–13) occupies a stunning 15-acre woodland setting, including its own sports fields and lake, adjacent to the Senior School. Road and rail connections are excellent, with Birmingham and Bristol Airports less than an hour away and London Heathrow no more than two.

Inside the classroom

All pupils are stretched academically and go on to achieve their best in a positive and supportive learning environment. The curriculum is broad and purposeful, with lessons complemented by extensive school trips, such as expeditions in the Himalayas, and over 30 clubs and societies. A wide range of GCSE and A-level subjects are offered in the Senior School, and over 95% of pupils go on to the university of their choice.

Beyond the classroom

There is a huge array of extracurricular activities both during the week and at weekends, from outdoor pursuits and film-making to astronomy and dance. Sport and sporting facilities are outstanding, with many pupils excelling nationally and internationally in a wide cross-section of sports. Many pupils learn a musical instrument and are part of the numerous groups and ensembles. Budding stage performers enjoy year group and house plays, as well as whole school productions, and artistically minded children have every opportunity to develop their creative flair.



Friendship matters

Community life and friendship are hugely important at Cheltenham College. Founded on Christian principles and with a strong house system at its heart, the school inspires loyalty, respect and integrity. Pastoral care is exceptional, with every pupil developing socially as well as academically. For boarders and day pupils alike, the warm and welcoming atmosphere in the houses combined with close relationships with teachers makes school feel like a real home from home.

Superb facilities

From an extensive sports complex and acres of sports fields to the theatre, a 19th-century art gallery and a breathtaking Chapel, the facilities at Cheltenham College are outstanding. College has recently completed the refurbishments of the library and performing arts centre, has upgraded the art and design centre and opened a new girls' boarding house at the Senior School. The Science Centre was completely refurbished last summer to provide College with state-of-the-art, university standard labs.

Scholarships

Worth 10–25% of the fees, scholarships are available at 11+, 13+ and 16+ across a variety of disciplines, including academic, music, art, drama, design and technology, sport and all-round. Bursaries and HM Forces family discounts are also available.
