Founded in 1893, Harrogate Ladies' College is a boarding and day school with around 320 pupils aged 11–18. We also have an associated Prep School and Pre-Prep, co-educational day schools for pupils aged 2–11, set in the College's grounds.

Academic excellence

Outstanding teaching, strong pastoral support and a secure, friendly community allow girls to excel academically and become confident, amazing young women who strive to be the very best they can be. In 2014 we achieved fantastic results and feel very proud of the hard work and effort made by our entire learning community. Our GCSE and A Level results were outstanding with 79% of girls achieving A*–B at GCSE and 71% of girls achieving grades A*–B at A Level. Over 87% of our girls secured places at their first or second choice university, including Russell Group universities.

Boarding

Nearly half the College's pupils are boarders, coming from over 20 different countries. The boarding houses are arranged vertically from Year 7 to Year 12. Year 13 students enjoy a greater sense of freedom in their own accommodation called 'Tower House'. This contains a large kitchen, comfortable lounges and relaxation areas. Each house has a housemistress and assistant housemistress who are responsible for the wellbeing of the girls.

Facilities and extracurricular

Our award-winning HLC Business School is where business, accounting, economics and psychology are taught by specialist teachers. Other purpose-built resource areas include a design and technology suite, food technology suite, science block, music house, sports hall and swimming pool. Girls



currently have a choice of over 22 GCSE and 27 A-level subjects.

All pupils in the Sixth Form have private study-rooms in school with internet access.

There is a wide range of clubs, societies and cultural activities which enhance the academic programme, leading to the successful step into tertiary education. In addition to academic achievements, the girls also excel in art, music and sport.

Location

The school is situated in the heart of the beautiful spa town of Harrogate on the edge of a National Park in rural North Yorkshire. It has good rail and road links, with easy access to Leeds Bradford Airport (20 minutes), Manchester (1 hour 40 minutes) and London Heathrow (35-minute shuttle flight). Accompanied transport is available from any location throughout the UK. Harrogate boasts a rich cultural programme, as do York and Leeds, each only 20 minutes away.

Harrogate Ladies' College combines the best aspects of a traditional British education with the skills, qualifications and modern outlook needed by today's young women.
