About Mill Hill School

Mill Hill School is London's leading co-educational boarding and day school. Offering boarding from 13+, Mill Hill has an international reputation for excellence which has been built over more than two centuries since its foundation in 1807. Set in 120 acres of parkland, the School benefits from a beautiful environment while being just half an hour from central London. Mill Hill is the Senior School of the Mill Hill School Foundation, with Belmont, the Mill Hill Preparatory School, offering day education for pupils aged 7 to 13 and Grimsdell, the Mill Hill Pre-Preparatory School being a day school for children aged 3 to 7. This year also sees the launch of The Mount, Mill Hill International School (see page 142 for further information).

Academic excellence

Mill Hill's pupils achieve excellent academic results. Typically around 50% of A level grades are A*/A, with approximately 75% at A*–B while nearly half of the GCSE grades are A*/A. Around three-quarters of our leavers win places at Russell Group universities and go on to study a wide range of subjects including medicine, law, engineering, criminology and neuroscience.

Curriculum

We aim to develop in every pupil self-discipline, responsibility, spiritual and moral values, leading to the highest possible standards of behaviour, consideration for others, pride in oneself and in one's achievements. We offer a broad, flexible and forward-looking academic curriculum which encourages intellectual curiosity, sound learning and a spirit of enquiry.







Boarding

Mill Hill offers full and weekly boarding options. Over 30 nationalities are represented in the boarding community of Mill Hill and the Mount, Mill Hill International School. The three boarding houses, set in the grounds of the school, each have their own matron, excellent facilities and tutor teams dedicated to the welfare of the boarding community. Mill Hill has been rated outstanding in all aspects of boarding in its two recent ISI inspections.

Extracurricular

Mill Hill is well known for the wealth of opportunities on offer in sport and the creative arts. Over 25 sporting activities are provided for on the 120-acre site, with provision being made for all ability levels. Mill Hill has extensive facilities for rugby, hockey, cricket and football. In addition there is a well-equipped sports hall and gym, netball courts, an indoor pool, recently resurfaced tennis courts and three new Eton Fives courts. Mill Hill also has a full time professional golf coach.

The facilities in the Music, Art and Design, Design Technology and Drama and Theatre Studies Departments have also been the subject of significant investment in the past decade. Pupils can also choose from over 50 lunchtime and after-school activities.
