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The Repton community

Repton School is fully co-educational with a strong boarding ethos and is home to 654 pupils. Centrally located in the picturesque village of Repton, yet with easy access to major motorways and airports, the heart of the School is based around the 12th-century Priory with its beautiful Garth and Cloisters. A cohesive, family environment is fostered by our traditional House system; we maintain in-house dining, day pupils are fully integrated with boarders and there is a strong and positive inter-house rivalry. Boarding houses are spread throughout the village so they feel part of the local community.

Achievement

Academic excellence remains at the heart of a Repton education, allowing each pupil to develop his or her potential to the maximum. We achieve excellent exam results at both GCSE and A-level, and on average 95% of our sixth-form leavers enter courses at a wide range of leading universities, including the prestigious colleges of Oxford and Cambridge.

Sport

Repton has a long tradition of sporting excellence, with a host of national and regional titles to its name. In the last five years Repton has reached 43 National Finals, winning 30 National Championship titles and securing a further 6 runners up places in sports including football, hockey, netball, cricket, swimming and tennis. Our sports programme has a positive influence on all ages and abilities of pupils and our facilities include all-weather hockey pitches, an indoor swimming pool, indoor tennis courts and a cricket ground that is the envy of many schools.

Repton is fortunate to possess superb facilities across the board to enable us to offer dedicated and inspiring environments to support pupils in all aspects of academic life, including music, drama and art. Last year we opened our impressive new Precinct Teaching Block, the new home of Maths and academic PE. In 2013 we opened our state-of-the-art Science Priory which gives further opportunities to promote excellence in science teaching, links with industry and external research projects.

Life at Foremarke Hall, Repton's Prep School

Foremarke is a boarding and day school for 470 boys and girls aged 3–13. Centred on a fine Georgian mansion and surrounded by 55 acres of beautiful grounds, Foremarke Hall inspires and captures the imagination of its children even before they have walked through the door. The School enjoys an enviable reputation for its excellent balance of academic and out-of-classroom opportunities with the provision of first-class facilities and teaching.

A strong boarding ethos lies at the heart of the School, and the inviting



grounds, stimulating buildings and friendly caring staff create a home from home for those who choose to board. Many teachers have their homes on site, and their families help to complete that all-important caring and safe community atmosphere. The weekend programme for boarders is full and varied, with busy Sundays spent using the wonderful facilities and grounds or experiencing a wide range of trips and outward bound activities.

Achievement

Foremarke has an excellent reputation for its high academic standards and prepares boys and girls for Common Entrance and Academic Scholarship to public school at 13+. Foremarke also has an outstanding record of awards at 13+ for sport, music, drama, art & design and technology.

Facilities

Set against a palladian Georgian mansion, our four boarding houses are now complemented by a recently completed building initiative with impressive facilities which will benefit all of the pupils. The project has seen the creation of a spacious new art studio, an industrially inspired Design and Technology Centre complete with its own Greenpower racing car pit and designated ICT suite. In addition to this there is a new purpose-built Music School, a sophisticated language facility, a humanities block and a speciality Learning Enhancement area.

Philosophy

As a school we believe that the most valuable education is one that is broad and balanced, enabling children to enjoy their childhood whilst benefiting from a wonderful range of opportunities both in and out of the classroom.



Foremarke Hall aims to produce young people at 13 who are confident without being arrogant, who achieve well in and out of the classroom and who appreciate the needs of others around them. Such young people will be well prepared for the senior phase of their education and for life beyond.
