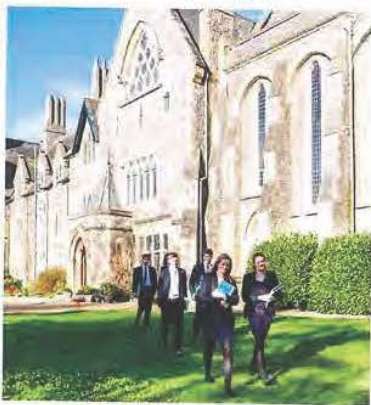
The school is situated on a large and beautiful site and overlooks the beautiful, historic city of Canterbury in Kent (South East England). It is ideally located for international pupils.
