With a capacity of around 250 students including 50 full or weekly boarders, St John's is large enough to provide a broad study programme yet small enough to retain a special family feel that is so valued by all the children, parents and staff.

An international perspective

The School is an International Education Systems (IES) school whose mission is to provide excellence in education with an international perspective. At St John's, the focus is on providing our students with the foundations that will help create rounded individuals who can succeed in any walk of life and on a national or international stage.

As part of that focus, the School aligns its teaching practices and methodologies with the International Baccalaureate system, encouraging academic excellence alongside a strong emphasis on the development of confident, reflective and caring young people and communities.

Junior School - Reception to Year 6

In the Junior School, the children study the International Baccalaureate Primary Years Programme (PYP) — which encourages the development of the child as an inquirer, both in the classroom and in the world outside. St John's is the only school in the South West of England that is an authorised IB World School to teach the PYP.

Senior School - Year 7 to Year 11

The Senior School builds on this learning by offering an integrated programme based on the National Curriculum, combined with a series of individual and theme-based projects to investigate and extend all topics – culminating in International GCSEs in Year 11.

Sixth Form

Our Sixth Form offers the best in international education to local and overseas students in their final two years of study, with small, tutorial style classes at the forefront of our approach.





Developing lifelong passions

In such a beautiful setting and with excellent facilities, it is no surprise that sport is a cornerstone of daily life at St John's. With the sea as a backdrop to our lovely grounds, the boys play rugby, football and cricket while the girls focus on hockey, netball and rounders.

Of course there are many other activities on the programme, including athletics, gymnastics, swimming and tennis, and there are always opportunities to make the very most of our location in beautiful Devon, including golf, sailing and walking on Dartmoor or Exmoor.
